**TO: SEX OFFENDERS WITH SPECIFIC SEX OFFENDER CONDITIONS**

**SUBJECT: Operation Scarecrow**

This letter is to remind you that you have a condition prohibiting or restricting contact with persons under the age of 18. The Division of Parole and Probation is instructing you that on Halloween, October 31, 2011, you are to avoid contact with children and not pass out candy or other Halloween treats.

On October 31, 2013, at 6:00 p.m. unless otherwise approved, you will be at your place of residence until 6 a.m. November 1. Exceptions may be made on a case by case basis by your supervising officer. Failure to abide by this order is a violation of your Parole, Probation, or Lifetime Supervision and you will be subject to arrest/violation proceedings/new charges as appropriate.

You will abide by your Special Conditions which state:

That you are not to be in or near playgrounds, schools or school grounds; Motion Picture Theater or business that primarily has children as customers or conducts events that primarily children attend or where children primarily congregate.

No Contact with Persons under 18 Years of Age: You shall not have contact with a person less than 18 years of age in a secluded environment unless another adult who has never been convicted of an offense listed in NRS 179D.410 is present.

You are instructed to darken your house and otherwise discourage "trick-or-treaters." Mark your residence with a sign indicating "No Candy."

For those offenders who have exceptions regarding contact with their own biological children, please contact your supervising officer regarding any questions you may have regarding Halloween activities.

If other members of your household intend to pass out Halloween candy, you are to vacate your residence during this time and advise your supervising officer of your expected location. You will not hand out candy to Trick-or-Treaters, and you will not go Trick-or-Treating with anyone. You will have your porch light turned off and you will not answer the door for Trick-or-Treaters if they should knock.
