I am currently under Lifetime Supervision in the state of Nevada. I am trying to move back to Arizona. In 2010, Officer Gothan, had given me a hard time to go and visit my sister who was dying of cancer. I had to go through Elaine Voight, to have her send an email to Officer Gothan's Superior in order for me to go back to Arizona to see my sister. I had two weeks to see her and see her die and went to her funeral. During that year, I kept asking Officer Gothan for permission to transfer to Arizona or get a travel permit. He has always denied me. I feel he was abusing his authority at the time. I did not know who to go to, until I told Elaine Voight. She helped me go see my sister for the very last time. I wish I had spent some time to see her and to visit her a few times. I hold that grudge against Parole and Probation. Therefore, I have intentionally violated my conditions to get sent back to prison and to apply for interstate compact while I am in prison. I am out, and in Reno now. I am waiting to see if Clark County is going to issue a warrant for my arrest for violation (DUI) of my condition for Lifetime Supervision. Please respond back as soon as possible as to what I can do.
