I hope I have come to the right place. I have a big problem with the State of Nevada Parole and Probation Dept. My fiancé of 18 years is currently on 3 years' probation for allegedly changing the price tag on a calculator at Walmart. She has completed over 2 years without a single problem. She hasn't been able to complete her 16 hours a month community service because of health issues related to her diabetes, all of which has been confirmed by more than one Doctor. On June 17th, she had to go to the hospital because her legs were very swollen and she was in too much pain. While there, she had to have her feet cut open to relieve the pressure. She was then taken to have her blood drawn and the Doctor scheduled her for surgery on June 18th. After I took her home I had to leave for work, she called her P.O. to tell him she had to have surgery the next day and he replied "you need to come in here today" so she called her sister to drive across town and crawled out of the car and into his office. When she got there he arrested her because she was 86ed from Walmart and he saw on her prescription bottle it was from Walmart. He went there, pulled the security tapes verified she went in and picked up her prescriptions and arrested her the day before she was supposed to have extremities removed. She went to court about a year and a half ago to get legal custody of her drug-addicted brother's 6-month-old baby and we've had him since then. This has taken a huge toll on her health. She is not a threat to society nor has she done anything that would constitute this action from him. Can you please give me some information on what legal action I can take against the department?
